

PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY FOR THE INFANT, PRESCHOOLER AND SCHOOL-AGE CHILD

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This Comprehensive Pediatric Dentistry review course provides an overview of current evidence-based, standard-of-care concepts related to the provision of dental care for children from birth to children in their mixed dentition. This 6 hour course is conveniently divided into three two-hour segments that focus on children in three distinct stages of their growth and development:

1. Infancy: Concepts related to infant oral health promotion.
2. Primary dentition: Dental problems and their management in the primary dentition in a preschool age child
3. Mixed dentition: Problems and management of problems in the transitional mixed dentition in a primary school age child.

Dr. Gajanan Kiran Kulkarni is a tenured Associate Professor of Dentistry at the University of Toronto where he has been working since 1998. After his undergraduate dental training he obtained a M.Sc. degree and followed that with a specialty diploma in Pediatric Dentistry and a Ph.D. in Cell and Molecular Biology from the University of Toronto. Following his formal education Dr. Kulkarni completed two post-doctoral fellowships at Guy’s Hospital, London, UK and Northwestern University, Chicago, IL, USA. He is presently a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. Dr. Kulkarni has over 150 publications and

presentations in various fields of basic and clinical dental research and he is on the editorial boards of several journals.

Dr. Kulkarni has presented numerous continuing education courses and is an invited speaker to national and international conferences.
