PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY FOR THE INFANT, PRESCHOOLER AND SCHOOL-AGE CHILD

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This Comprehensive Pediatric Dentistry review course provides an overview of current evidence-based, standard-of-care concepts related to the provision of dental care for children from birth to children in their mixed dentition. This 6 hour course is conveniently divided into three two-hour segments that focus on children in three distinct stages of their growth and development:

- 1. Infancy: Concepts related to infant oral health promotion.
- Primary dentition: Dental problems and their management in the primary dentition in a preschool age child
- Mixed dentition: Problems and management of problems in the transitional mixed dentition in a primary school age child.
