Shavell, "Morphology and Occlusion is the Common Denominator of All Dentistry." Every restoration placed has the potential to alter the occlusal relationship of the patients' dentition. Thus, understanding, visualizing, and reproducing proper dentate morphology, regardless of the material used... is the key to long-lasting dental restoration. In this lecture, Dr. Lowe will review in detail techniques to create direct, provisional, and definitive restorations that show how the principles of morphology and occlusion can be maintained using today's modern dental materials to produce "world class" dental restorations.
