The abused mouth: from cocaine to cigarettes, meth mouth to marijuana.

A clinical stroll through the oral effects of drugs, products, habits and psychoses.

This clinically oriented seminar will review a variety of oral mucosal and jawbone responses and “injuries” resulting from the local use of medications, tobaccos, habits and recreational drugs. It will also review responses to systemic drugs and diseases, as well as factitial injuries, bulimia and oral precancers. Taken together, this group of confusing entities is difficult to diagnose and treatment is often problematic. The seminar will, therefore, emphasize differential diagnosis and therapeutic options.

**Objectives: Upon completion of this presentation, participants will understand the following:**

- The many oral mucosal effects of recreational and prescribed medications
- The oral effects of certain habits (bulimia, gum and candy chewing, lemon sucking, etc.)
- The early detection and management of oral precancers and early cancers
- The differential diagnosis and treatment options for a wide variety of oral mucosal effects of drugs, other products and certain habits

## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

**Jerry Bouquot, DDS, MSD, FAAOMP DABOMP, FICD, FADI, FACD**

Dr. Bouquot was trained at the University of Minnesota and for 18 years was the Chair of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology at West Virginia University. He is co-author of the most popular textbook of oral pathology and has been President of the American Board of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology, a Senior Visiting Scientist at the Mayo Clinic and a Director of the national Board of Directors of the American Cancer Society. He has won numerous teaching, service and research awards, including the St. George Medal, the highest award given by the American Cancer Society. He has published more than 220 papers, abstracts and book chapters, and has given well over 1,100 continuing education and research talks around the world. In his seminars he emphasizes clinical features of disease, differential diagnosis and disease management, with much practical information based on his lifetime experience in an active clinical oral pathology (oral medicine) practice and one of the nation=s largest oral pathology biopsy services. Dr. Bouquot=s precancer research has been cited thousands of times in the literature and he selected to represent North America on the recent WHO Task Force on Oral Premalignant Lesions & Conditions. He manages two informational websites, one of which is the most popular oral pathology site (*oralpath.com*); these together receive approximately 7,000,000 hits annually. His popular Power Point presentations on common oral lesions and differential diagnosis are used by dental professionals worldwide. Recently, the Texas Medical Center gave him the Fleming and Davenport Award for original research, pertaining to oral precancers. He is publishing a series of papers pertaining to “the abused mouth.”
