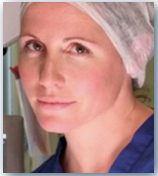
COURSE DESCRIPTION



In observance of Oral Cancer Awareness Month, we would like to invite you to join us at the third Cook County Health Symposium on Oral Oncology on Saturday and Sunday, April 18th & 19th, 2020. This one and a half day program focuses on the diagnosis and management of the oral cancer patient. The second day consists of special session on the role of sentinel lymph node biopsy in the treatment of oral cavity cancers.

The meeting is geared towards dental and medical providers including general dentists, oral & maxillofacial surgeons, and otolaryngologists. The highlight of the program will be the lectures by our three key-note speakers on the management of the neck and the sentinel lymph node biopsy technique.

Key Note Speakers:



Clare Schilling BDS, MD, Ph.D, FRCS, is a head and neck surgeon and consultant in oral and maxillofacial surgery at University College, London. She is considered an authority and a pioneer in the field of sentinel lymph node biopsy for oral cavity cancers, and led the seminal multi-institutional SENT trial. She is active with multiple multi-institutional clinical trials and has helped set up a national training program for sentinel lymph node biopsy in the United Kingdom.



Robert Ord DDS, MD, MS, FACS, FRCS is professor and chair of oral & maxillofacial surgery at the University of Maryland. He has a practice dedicated to oral and head & neck oncology. He is involved in resident and fellow training. He has published over 85 peer reviewed journal articles and 25 book chapters. He is the editor of multiple textbooks on oral cancer and salivary gland disease, and serves on the editorial board for the oncology and pathology sections for multiple peer reviewed journals.



Mark McGurk BDS, MD, FRCS is professor, head and neck/ oral & maxillofacial consultant at University College Hospital, London. Dr. MCGurk authored extensively in the field of head and neck oncology and salivary gland tumors with over 200 peer reviewed articles and 5 major textbooks. He is previous editor of the British Journal of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr. McGurk helped lead the seminal SENT trial, and the international consensus paper on sentinel lymph node biopsy.
