The "Jacked-Up" Dentition - Demystifying Full Mouth Rehabilitation

COURSE OUTLINE

This course is designed for the progressive restorative dentist who wants to feel more confident in providing full-mouth rehabilitation. Several well-documented cases will be covered from the initial workup to the post treatment follow-up, detailing the TMJ, Perio, Surgery, Occlusal Management, Aesthetic Considerations, materials, techniques, and future risk mitigation. The participant will leave with a thorough understanding of the necessary steps to take a nervous patient with multiple dental issues and bring them to a state of dental health and self-esteem.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- The proper examination, treatment planning and case presentation protocol for full-mouth rehabilitation.
- How to break difficult cases down to the 5 basic elements of dental health.
- The necessary tools (materials, techniques, education and equipment) necessary to finish these cases predictably.



Dr. Jeffrey W.
