Root Canals Done Better, Faster and Safer: A Practical Course for GPs

AM WORKSHOP

Many topics with practical tips and tricks will be presented to help general dentists perform better root canals with less stress and more efficiency. This will include endo diagnosis, anaesthesia, access preparations, safer and faster instrumentation, obturation, analgesic and antibiotics in endo, and one vs. two appointment endo. The program is tailored to novice and experienced GPs.

Learning Objectives

1. **FASTER.** Learn how to more efficiently: locate canals (including MB2), instrument and obturate with fewer steps, and one vs two appointment root canals.
2. **BETTER.** Learn how to better: access teeth, locate and instrument cal'd canals, follow canal curvatures, anesthetize (hot) teeth, improve intra-canal medications.
3. **SAFER.** Learn how to separate less files, prevent perforations, avoid canal ledging / blocking, prevent obturation extrusion, reduce post-op pain.

PM WORKSHOP

This hands-on program is tailored for general dentists. Participants will learn, via exercises on acrylic and extracted teeth, how to locate and negotiate canals, instrument and obturate more efficiently and safely.

Learning Objectives

- Practice the essentials in stainless steel and NiTi file handling and canal preparation.
- Learn to locate and negotiate calcified and curved canals (including MB2) using efficient NiTi files.
- Learn how to obturate the workshop's instrumented teeth in 3D, predict ably and efficiently. Note to participants: you will be required to bring at least three previously accessed but not instrumented extracted teeth, stored in bleach.

Please bring accessed teeth.



Dr. Manor Haas is a Certified Specialist in Endodontics and is extensively involved in continuing dental education with emphasis on advanced instrumentation, obturation, and the benefits of 3D imaging in endodontics.
