

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Implant Dentistry has evolved significantly over the last few years. **Day 1** of this course will cover topics that will help the participant increase the case acceptance of implant Dentistry in their practices and at the same time learn how to avoid common complications. Factors influencing the implant selection and placement will be discussed. **Day 2** will be a hands-on opportunity for participants to plan treatment based on cases he/she has individually provided as well as surgical and restoration of dental implant placement.

ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

Dr. Robert Blackwell received his dental degree from the University of Illinois College of Dentistry and completed a General Practice Residency at Michael Reese Hospital and Medical Center in Chicago, Illinois. He is a member of the American Dental Association, Academy of General Dentistry, American Dental Education Association and the Academy of Osseointegration. He is a Fellow of both the Academy of General Dentistry and the International College of Dentists. Dr. Blackwell is a Clinical Professor and the Chair of the Department of Graduate Education at the Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine. He has lectured both nationally and internationally for over 30 years. Dr. Blackwell maintains a private restorative practice with an emphasis on implant restoration.

Dr. William Cusack received his Doctor of Dental Science at the University Of Illinois College Of Dentistry. Dr. Cusack practiced general dentistry before returning to the University of Illinois for his specialty certificate in Periodontics. He has had his practice in Peoria for 33 years and it is limited to periodontics and dental implants. Dr. Cusack is a faculty member at Illinois Central College where he has taught periodontology as part of the dental hygiene curriculum for the past thirty-eight years. He holds seminars emphasizing the use of present scientific knowledge to formulate practical treatment modalities for patients with consideration given to the need for explaining these procedures to the patients. Dr. Cusack is a member of the American Dental Association, American Academy of Periodontology, Illinois Dental Society, Peoria Dental District Society, and the Chicago Dental Society.
