049/20	MODIFICATIONS TO ALNAV 044/20 REISSUANCE OF DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019	4/22/2020	This ALNAV supersedes ALNAV 044/20 and provides an update and guidance to Department of the Navy (DON) personnel and commands on domestic and international travel restrictions. All DON personnel, and their families, including active, reserve, and civilian personnel whose travel is government-funded will stop movement, both internationally and domestically. This ALNAV also delineates limited circumstances that are exempt from these restrictions.

036/20	2020 ACTIVE DUTY FUND DRIVE IN SUPPORT OF THE NAVY-MARINE CORPS RELIEF SOCIETY	4/02/2020	The 2020 Active Duty fund drive supporting the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society (NMCRS) was scheduled to run from 1 March 2020 through 30 April 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this fund drive is being extended to 30 June 2020.
035/20	SPECIAL DUTY MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS UPDATE TO POLICY IN RESPONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019	3/31/2020	This ALNAV announces a temporary change to the requirement for Special Duty Medical Examinations in response to COVID-19. All Navy and Marine Corps personnel requiring a Special Duty Medical Examination for dive, flight, landing craft air cushion, naval special warfare and special operations, nuclear field duty, radiation, and submarine duty status in the months of March 2020 through June 2020 are authorized an extension of four months from date of current exam expiration.
029/20	STATE AND LOCAL SHELTER-IN-PLACE ORDERS IMPACT ON DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY OPERATIONS	3/23/2020	This ALNAV provides guidance to Department of the Navy (DON) Commanders and all personnel regarding state and local government shelter-in-place, stay-at-home, self-quarantine, or similar executive orders and the DON COVID-19 response.
026/20	OFFICIAL AND PERSONAL DOMESTIC TRAVEL FORCE HEALTH PROTECTION GUIDANCE FOR DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY (CONUS TRAVEL GUIDANCE)	3/14/2020	This ALNAV provides an update and guidance to DON personnel and commands on the COVID-19 outbreak on domestic travel restrictions and is subject to additional guidance provided by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) regarding continental United States and its territories. Anticipate modifications to this policy over the next several weeks as additional information becomes available.
025/20	VECTOR 15 FORCE HEALTH PROTECTION GUIDANCE FOR DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY	3/12/2020	This ALNAV provides guidance to DON personnel and commands on the COVID-19 outbreak and is subject to additional guidance provided by the Secretary of Defense.

116/20	NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 4	4/21/2020	This NAVADMIN cancels NAVADMIN 080/20 and extends the ongoing stop movement travel restrictions to 30 June 2020. In addition, this NAVADMIN provides clarifying guidance on other COVID-19 related issues and policy changes, contains measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 throughout the Navy enterprise and amplifies DoD and DoN direction for Navy Service Members and Navy civilians. It summarizes and repeats applicable guidance where appropriate to serve as a one-stop information source.
115/20	UPDATE TO NAVY COVID-19 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS	4/21/2020	This NAVADMIN provides updated reporting guidance while the Navy continues to operate in a COVID-19 environment. All OPREP-3 messages sent related to COVID-19, will be reported as detailed in this NAVADMIN. This message supersedes the reporting guidance in NAVADMIN 080/20. The reporting guidance is significantly enhanced to better understand COVID-19 positive, suspect COVID-19 cases, and command actions at sea.
114/20	POLICY GUIDANCE UPDATE FOR IDENTIFICATION CARD SERVICES FOR COVID-19	4/21/2020	This NAVADMIN provides an update to temporary guidance for Navy personnel who require Common Access Card (CAC) and Uniformed Services Identification (USID) Card services during the COVID-19 emergency. This NAVADMIN supplements NAVADMIN 097/20, but does not cancel it.
113/20	RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM) GUIDANCE UPDATE	4/17/2020	This NAVADMIN supersedes NAVADMIN 083/20 and acknowledges that operational unit commanders may have to execute a Restriction of Movement (ROM) period prior to introducing new members to the crew or prior to taking a unit overseas or underway. During ROM, Service Members should be restricted to their residence or other appropriate domicile and limit close contact (within 6 feet or 2 meters) with others. This NAVADMIN clarifies the definition of ROM, provides amplifying guidance, and delineates responsibilities for execution of ROM.
109/20	COVID-19 UPDATE GUIDANCE TO SUPPORT FLEET OPERATIONS	4/15/2020	The Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) has impacted our Fleet in profound and enduring ways. However, the priorities the CNO stated in his message to the Fleet on 8 April also endure. First, our health and safety. Second, ongoing fleet operations and our support to the coronavirus effort. Third, generating the support required to keep the first two on track.
105/20	EXPANDED OPPORTUNITY FOR RETENTION ON ACTIVE-DUTY IN A RETIRED STATUS FOR ACTIVE-DUTY OFFICERS WITH PENDING STATUTORY RETIREMENTS	4/09/2020	The Navy is accepting applications from active-duty and full-time support (FTS) officers in the rank of captain or below with a statutory retirement date between now and 1 December 2020 who desire to be retained on active-duty in a retired status (often referred to as retire/retain). The period of retention, if granted, would extend through 31 December 2020, or earlier if requested. Requests must be received prior to the retirement date of the officer, but not later than 1 July 2020.

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102/20	CASUALTY AND MORTUARY AFFAIRS PROCESSES IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19	4/07/2020	This NAVADMIN announces interim casualty and mortuary affairs program changes necessary to mitigate risk to the force due to the COVID-19 national emergency. This NAVADMIN is issued pending OSD and DON policy still in development. Upon release of the OSD and DON guidance, this NAVADMIN will be modified accordingly.
100/20	NAVY GUIDANCE ON THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS	4/05/2020	All individuals on DoD property, installations, and facilities are required to wear a cloth face covering when they cannot maintain 6 feet of social distance.
097/20	COMMON ACCESS CARD ISSUANCE POLICY UPDATE FOR COVID-19	4/02/2020	All Navy Real-Time Automated Personnel Identification System (RAPIDS) sites will only accept customers who have made CAC online appointments. If unable to schedule an appointment, customers will be serviced via a controlled walk-in process for CAC PIN resets only.
093/20	COMMERCIAL VIRTUAL REMOTE (CVR) COLLABORATION ENVIRONMENT (CORRECTED COPY)	3/27/2020	The DoD Commercial Virtual Remote (CVR) is a limited/temporary DoD-only instance of Microsoft Teams and OneDrive for Business (ODfB), a communication and collaboration, cloud-based platform integrated with Microsoft Office 365.
092/20	URINALYSIS POLICY UPDATE	3/27/2020	Commands will continue random urinalysis specimen collection from Sailors during the COVID-19 pandemic to the greatest extent possible. Commanders and Commanding Officers may pause collection and/or reduce collection percentages and numbers of days collected if he/she deems it necessary to support maximum operational flexibility and/or COVID-19 mitigation efforts.
089/20	VOLUNTARY EXTENSIONS FOR ACTIVE COMPONENT NAVY MEMBERS WITH APPROVED SEPARATION OR RETIREMENT DATES	3/26/2020	The Navy is accepting applications from officers and enlisted personnel who desire to delay their separation or retirement. Service members with an approved separation or retirement date before 1 April 2021 are eligible to submit a request to their detailer to have their separation or retirement date delayed between 6 and 12 months. Requests must be received by 1 July 2020.
083/20	RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM) GUIDANCE	3/23/2020	This NAVADMIN clarifies the definition of "Restriction of Movement" (ROM), provides amplifying guidance, and delineates responsibilities for execution of ROM.
082/20	NAVY TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM POLICY UPDATE FOR COVID-19	3/23/2020	This NAVADMIN announces the immediate suspension of all Navy Transition Assistance Program (TAP) in-person classes until further notice. Service Members with upcoming separation dates, who are unable to reschedule TAP attendance for a later date, must complete TAP via Joint Knowledge Online (JKO).
080/20	NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 3	3/21/2020	This NAVADMIN supersedes 3 previous NAVADMINs (064/20; 065/20; and 074/20) and consolidates those NAVADMINs into one NAVADMIN for ease of reference.
074/20	NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 2	3/19/2020	This NAVADMIN supersedes 2 NAVADMINs (064/20 and 065/20) and provides additional information concerning Permanent Change of Station (PCS) of Navy civilians, travel for official training, personal leave for Navy civilians, delegation of exception authority and regular reporting requirements.

073/20	TEMPORARY RELAXATION OF HAIR GROOMING STANDARDS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK	3/18/2020	Commanding Officers are authorized to relax the Navy hair length grooming standards for Sailors assigned to their command. Relaxed hair length grooming standards will only apply to the area of the scalp. Policy guidance regarding sideburns, hair styles and shaving requirements remains in effect.
072/20	POSTPONEMENT OF SELECTION BOARD SCHEDULE	3/18/2020	This NAVADMIN announces all promotion, advancement, milestone and other selection boards scheduled to convene on or after 24 March 2020 at Navy Personnel Command (NPC) are postponed until further notice.
071/20	PHYSICAL READINESS POLICY UPDATE	3/18/2020	This NAVADMIN announces immediate suspension of the Navy physical readiness program physical fitness assessment (PFA) for Cycle 1, 2020 to minimize the risk from COVID-19 to Sailors and adhere to social distancing requirements. All personnel will be excused from participation in Cycle 1, 2020, including those who have already completed the PFA.
068/20	EFFECTIVE USE OF REMOTE WORK OPTIONS	3/17/2020	This NAVADMIN provided guidance for shore commands using Navy and Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI) and ONE-NET, describing the capacity of remote work resources and the priority in which they should be leveraged.
065/20	NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 1	3/14/2020	This NAVADMIN supplements guidance in NAVADMIN 064/20 and announces domestic travel and movement restrictions to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 throughout the Navy.
064/20	NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK	3/12/2020	This NAVADMIN announces further measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 throughout the Navy enterprise and amplifies DoD and DON guidance for Navy military members. It summarizes and repeats applicable guidance where appropriate so that this will serve as a one-stop information source.
058/20	UPDATED GUIDANCE DURING THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK	3/05/2020	This NAVADMIN directs the submission of a daily report for all Navy component commands (via email) to the OPNAV Navy Operations Center/Battle Watch Captain NLT 1700 Zulu daily until complete. Negative reports are required.
039/20	UPDATED DOD GUIDANCE FOR MONITORING PERSONNEL RETURNING FROM CHINA DURING THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK	2/11/2020	This NAVADMIN directed all Navy commands to identify all servicemembers returning from mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau after 2 Feb 2020. Commands will place these servicemembers under a 14 day Restriction of Movement (ROM).
